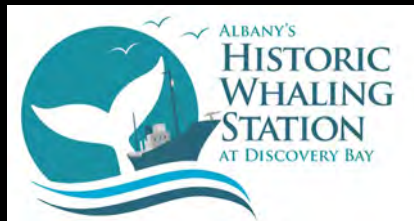


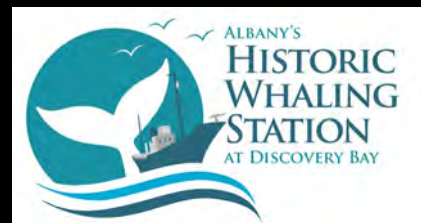




**Skeleton Display**







From a three-year process of public and industry consultation and workshops started in 2004, a more elaborate plan for a multi-faceted tourism precinct emerged. All but one of the major modules have been completed. The last and most costly, a subterranean eco-village, is at detailed concept design stage.

The name "Discovery Bay" was selected in recognition of Capt. George Vancouver's lead ship "Discovery" that drew water from the site in 1791.

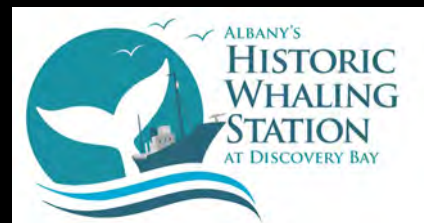

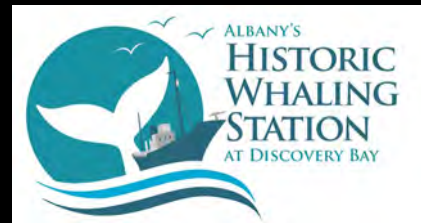
**Storm Water Management – A Wetland Beneficiary**

**appropriate plant species**





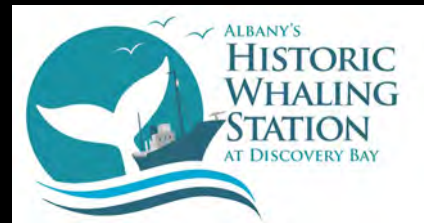


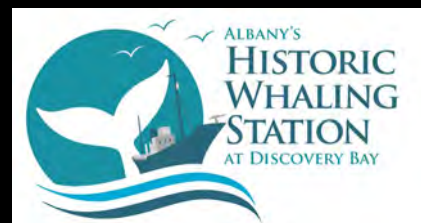
